

Camp Policies and Behavior

Behavior and Discipline

The Weston Youth Center for Musical Arts is looking forward to providing your child with a memorable and safe summer music camp experience. It is the campers' responsibility to act in a way that assures a positive experience for all. All WYCMA campers are required to follow these standards.

Expected Behavior

- Campers must be responsible for their words and actions.
- Campers must be respectful of others.
- Campers must follow directions from staff members.
- Campers are responsible for all electronic devices and instruments they bring to camp.

Prohibited Behaviors & Grounds for Immediate Dismissal of the Program

- Endangering the health and safety of themselves, other campers, and/or staff and volunteers.
- Stealing, damaging, or failing to care for any property on Camp Campus or personal property.
- Inappropriate use of technology or social media at Camp
- Inappropriate physical contact
- Profanity/inappropriate language
- Bullying or acts of aggression or violence towards other campers and/or staff and volunteers.
- Possession or use of illegal substances, vape products, tobacco, and/or alcohol.
- Possession of weapons- any object that may cause harm to another or place another person in fear of his/her safety, may be considered a weapon.

Steps taken for failure to follow these Behavior Standards

- Staff will redirect the camper to a more appropriate behavior and be given a warning.
- If the behavior persists, staff will discuss the problem with parent/guardian.
- The Staff and/or Director will document the situation for a parent/guardian signature.
- If the problem persists, the Camp Director may find it necessary to have the camper picked up early from the camp.
- If a camper's behavior at any time threatens the immediate safety of him/her, other campers, or staff, the parent/guardian will be notified and expected to pick up the child immediately.
